When you are doing research for an internship or job opportunity you want to look at these items below.

Research

- 1. Industry you want to work in
- 2. Companies that interest you
- 3. Job titles that interests you
- 4. Responsibilities that fit your skill set
- 5. Competitors of the companies that interest you.
- 6. Research trade journals and press releases

Sites to use for the research above:

- 1. For internships and jobs Indeed, Monster, Dyce, LinkedIn, Glassdoor
- 2. Internlocator.com for internships
- 3. Research on company culture use Glassdoor
 - a. **NOTE:** if the company interest you and you are not seeing a positive review, o not discount the company. Apply and get an interview and make the decision for yourself
- 4. If the company is publicly traded Yahoo Finance or company website investor relations
 - a. Financial status of the company is in the 10Q and !OK
 - b. Check companies 8K filings for announcements
 - c. You can see who their competitors are

Print out the job description and make notes, print out research I.e., press releases make notes
